

The federal government should do more to protect Canada's forests and wildlife











Importance of reducing primary forest loss




Views on protecting forests



Canada should include strong action to reduce greenhouse gas emissions from logging in its 2030 Emissions Reduction Plan, which is expected to be released in March





Large companies should pay a carbon price on net greenhouse gas emissions from burning wood, as they do when they burn other fuels







Importance of accurate reporting




