We are looking for a candidate to develop and implement our major gifts strategy. Someone who will bring all their creativity and passion to the challenge; someone who is a facilitator of philanthropy, a connector of people. A successful candidate will understand that our donors are the real heroes in our story and we enable them to fulfil their dreams through giving to Nature Canada.

This job will provide support and leadership to our Women for Nature program. More than a giving circle, Women for Nature is a powerhouse of potential for our campaign goals. This diverse network works with Nature Canada to improve environmental policy in Canada and we want to ensure we have a consistent point person to support and engage them, strategically and respectfully.

This is an exciting position that involves building relationships across the country. While primary outcomes will be fundraising, there is also a campaign element to the job and we are looking for someone who will be able to see the key moments when our wider



community can be engaged in various ways to help advance the strategic goals of Nature Canada.

ORGANIZATION

Nature Canada connects the dots between local action and systemic change. For more than 80 years, we have been Canada's voice for nature. We work to ensure that solving the biodiversity crisis is a government priority. We advocate on behalf of other species for habitat protection and good policy. We facilitate mobilization among our extensive network of partners and individual nature-lovers to achieve our shared goals and generate the political will for needed transformation.

DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES

As the longest-standing nature charity in Canada, we have a deep history of supporters, with more coming along all the time. We want to augment our successful annual giving



and legacy programs by adding capacity for a more personal touch. Your job would be to develop the strategy, do the research, develop and manage relationships and solicit gifts. We would also rely on you to ensure we are properly thanking and honouring our major donors. The goal of the position includes securing funds for the organization by developing a group of donors and working to convert and retain as many as possible in their giving and involvement.

Your duties include building on our engagement strategy for our network of Women for Nature. Working with our Campaign and Policy team to keep abreast of developments on issues of interest for both our donors and our Women for Nature circle, you will help us to make strategic connections at key moments. You will help us to recruit new members from diverse geographies, communities and sectors and support them in their journey with us.

The position is based in Ottawa. This position joins a team of development professionals, reporting to the Director of Development.
